Paul's pastoral strategy



- •2:2 'My purpose is that they may be encouraged in heart and united in love, so that they may have the full riches of complete understanding.'
- •2:3 'in order that they may know the mystery of God, namely Christ, in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.'


