

Limitations of Traditional Approaches

- Can't produce enough graduates
- Inaccessibility
- Most training is aimed at the "fulltime" leaders.
- Existing "elder conference" often loose focus

What Is Needed

- Access to biblical/theological training
- Understanding of primary local church shepherding
- Emphasis on leadership character.
- Skills training: Leading, teaching, protecting, caring.
- In-church training

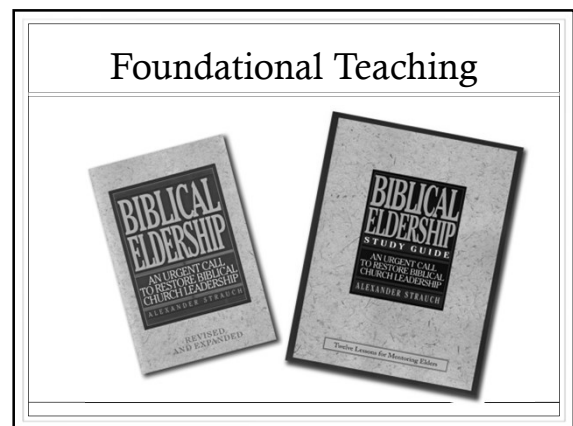
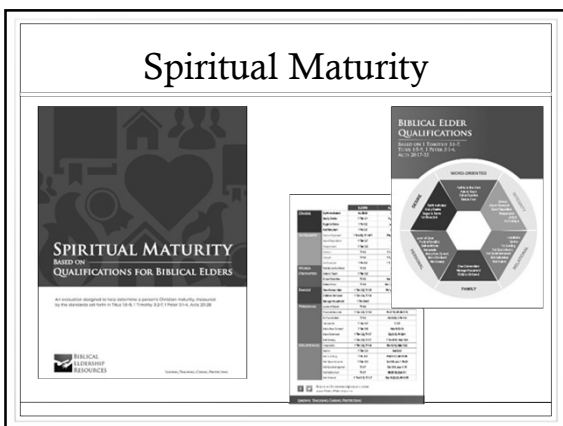
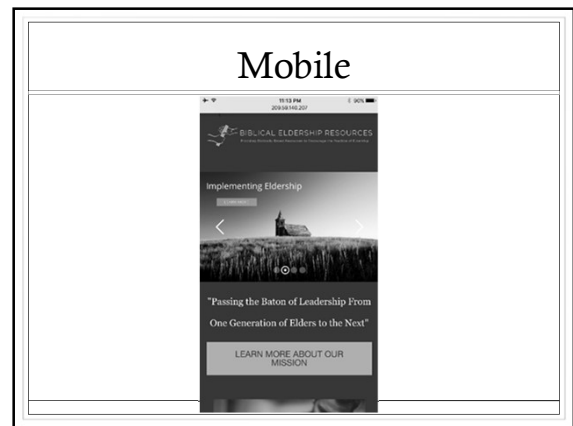
Three Areas of the Website
